

Repayment of money from incorrect payments of cadastral survey fees in the 107 regions

Repayment of money to the owners who by mistake have paid incorrect amounts (overpayment) regarding the rights they declared during the cadastral survey of the 107 regions is underway; these owners had submitted a Cadastral Survey Fee Repayment Application.

The Cadastral Survey Fee Repayment Applications came up to a total of **79,500**; **40%** of which has already been repaid. For the rest of them, the identification and attestation of due sum procedure has already been completed. The deposit of the sums at banks is also about to begin. It is estimated that the procedure will have been completed by late April.

After the deadline for the submission of declarations expired, Ktimatologio S.A. checked the database, attested the mistaken payments as well as the exact due sum, so the corresponding sums are being deposited at the bank accounts designated by the beneficiaries.

Mistaken bank account numbers

During the procedure mentioned above, extensive mistakes were ascertained at the bank account numbers that were declared by many beneficiaries; the result was that the sums could not be repaid by the respective banks. For these cases, it was decided that the safest and fastest solution was to inform beneficiaries with personal notifications that will be dispatched by post to the addresses they have declared. With these personal notifications, beneficiaries will be able to collect the sum attested for them at any branch of the bank mentioned in the notification.

To collect the sum, except for the personal notification, it will be also necessary to present their Identification Card and any document reading the Tax Identification Number (AFM) of the beneficiary.
